



ALLOTMENT NEWSLETTER No. 3 JUNE 2011

Rental Increases

As you will see from the enclosed invoice, the rent for the allotments has increased. It became clear that there was no standard plot size and the Parish Council took the decision to charge for the plots according to a sliding scale of sizes, this seemed a much fairer way of pricing.

There are five bands with different rents, plots that measure:

- up to 1500 sq ft = £18 per annum
- up to 2000 sq ft = £20 per annum
- up to 2500 sq ft = £22 per annum
- up to 3000 sq ft = £24 per annum
- over 3000 sq ft = £26 per annum

If you have any queries regarding this please don't hesitate to contact the Parish Council to discuss it.

Gentle reminders

Allotment rent must be paid within 30 days of invoice date.

All rubbish should be taken home and not dumped. The rubbish by the gates is Parish Council rubbish collected by the caretaker and is disposed of separately. Please don't add to it.
